




An intense ruby red in color, the wine shows attractive and complex aromas of red berry fruit, sweet spices, and toasted coffee. The flavors are full, round, and of high level balance and pleasure. It will be a vintage well capable of improving over time.

































Stags' Leap Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley




- The Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is deep and dense, showing a heady bouquet of dark plum, blackberry and hints of vanilla and cinnamon spice which continues through on the palate with beautiful dark berry and cassis, giving this Cabernet a classic elegance and feel. Seamlessly integrated oak and refined tannins provide a silky texture while the bright, fresh, dark blackberry fruit flavors and hints of black pepper, cocoa nib and coffee with a slight savory-ness on the finish, balance the wine's impressive concentration.

Vina Alicia Paso de Piedra Cabernet Sauvignon




- Winemaker's Notes
- An intense, dark color. There are raspberry-like aromas and a complexity associated with this noble grape. Fresh, well-balanced, with gobs of dark fruit, great acidity, and mature tannins. This is an unctuous and elegant wine. In the mouth it is profound, round, fleshy, and with soft but potent tannins.

LOS VASCOS Reserve




- Cabernet Sauvignon is the classic grape of Los Vascos' vineyard and is the variety on which the estate has built its reputation.
- The common feature of all the vintages is ripe fruit, fresh aromas, and a supple, full-bodied structure.
- This wine has a sparkling ruby red colour and a pleasantly fruity nose with aromas of black cherries, raspberries and plums, all with a hint of spice.
- This is a silky, flavourful wine, with a supple tannin structure.
